

CROHAM PLACE

Located in South Croydon, Croham Place is in a unique position to be out of the busy town, but with regular public transport links, service users are able to access the shopping centre with ease, where they can enjoy the cinema, restaurants, bowling, shopping etc. There is a small shopping parade within a 5-minute walk that boasts of hairdressers, butchers, convenience shop and post office.



Croham Place is made up of three units that cater to 35 service users, supported by a dedicated team that include Registered Service Manager, Clinical Lead, Operations Manager, Physiotherapist, Registered Mental Health Nurses, Registered General Nurses, Senior Carers, Support Workers, Activities Coordinator, full time Cook and Domestic Assistants.

We work with the GP, community mental health teams, district nurses, palliative care teams and occupational therapists. We have the Domiciliary Dentist and opticians visit the home regularly.

The three units are:

The Beeches – 12 bedroom female unit

The Manor – 14 bedroom mixed male and female unit

The Nightingales – 9 bedroom male unit



Croham Place is a specialist mental health and acquired brain injury/ neurocognitive care home located in South Croydon, Surrey which supports up to thirty-five service users over three separate units, The Manor, The Beeches and Nightingales. We focus on improving service user's quality of life through promoting independence and empowerment, while supporting our service users to reach their maximum rehabilitation potential.

Inclusion Criteria

- Male and Female, 18 years and older.
- Mental health diagnosis.
- Physical disability and/or complex needs.
- Neurological disorders, including any form of Dementia, Huntington's, Korsakoff's, and Alzheimer's Disease.
- Acquired brain injury/neurocognitive disorders.
- Risks requiring a specialist environment.
- Challenging behaviour.
- Forensic or significant risk history.
- Informal or subject to DoLS, conditional discharges, or community treatment order (CTO).



The Manor

The Manor is a 14 bedded unit in the main building over 2 floors. The unit supports males and female service users with a diagnosis of acquired brain injury (ABI) and/or Mental Health issues who also have complex nursing needs and physical disabilities. The majority of people we support on an ongoing basis suffer from limb paralysis and are wheelchair bound.

We have hoists in every room, large spacious areas and widened doorways for accessibility. Croham Place provides an in-house physiotherapy service led by a physiotherapist registered with both the Chartered Society of Physiotherapy (CSP) and the Health & Care Professions Council.



The Beeches

The Beeches is a dedicated unit, providing care and support for up to 12 female service users. The unit offers a comfortable, homely environment designed to meet both the physical and mental health needs of our residents. Located on the ground floor, the unit offers individual bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms for seven residents, and five additional bedrooms with access to two shared bathrooms.

There is a private garden and outdoor space where residents can come and go freely. The communal areas are spacious, bright, and welcoming, with provisions to accommodate necessary equipment for supporting service users. For those who need a quieter space away from noise, there is a designated quiet room. The dining room offers modern comfort with accessible facilities, and all meals are prepared by our on-site cook.



The Nightingales

The Nightingales has staff dedicated to supporting male service users of working age. The Nightingales support gentleman with mental health and or neurocognitive/acquired brain injury conditions.

The unit provides 9 bedrooms, each with an ensuite toilet, 2 communal shower rooms, a spacious lounge and dining room, a quiet room, a fully fitted kitchen to promote rehabilitation and independence, and a private garden.



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
